IMPORTANT: By February 1, 2010 (by the end of the fall 2009 semester), all applicants must meet the following requirements: A minimum Curricular GPA of 2.5 or better, and good academic standing (minimum 2.0 Cumulative GPA) at the most recent education institution attended is required. Any student not in good academic standing will be required to complete a minimum of 12 curricular credits with achievement of a 2.5 GPA or better. If all curricular courses have been successfully completed, the applicant may take transfer level courses to meet the 12 credit requirement or repeat curricular courses to improve individual course grades. Standing grades of D's and F's will be calculated into the curricular GPA **regardless** if they were taken at MECC or another college. Your high school and/or college transcript must indicate a grade of **'C' or better in Algebra I, General Biology with lab, and Chemistry.** Algebra I part 1, basic algebra, applied biology, and consumer chemistry do not satisfy pre-requisite requirements. Algebra I parts 1 and 2 will satisfy the algebra I requirement. Completion of college placement tests (ASSET or COMPASS) indicating placement into English 111 and Math 126 (or satisfactory completion of required developmental courses) is also required. **In addition, By February 1, 2010, LPN to RN BRIDGE applicants must have evidence on file indicating completion of or enrollment in the following requirements for the spring 2010 semester (All requirements listed below MUST be met by the end of the spring 2010 semester):** one semester of College coursework in **BIO 141, BIO 142, ENG 111, ENG 112, MTH 126, and SDV 100, all with a final grade of 'C' or better.** (Anatomy & Physiology I and II must have been completed within 10 years prior to admission to the nursing program). **If you do not meet the minimum requirements by the deadlines specified, we will suspend processing your application and you must schedule a meeting with the Nursing faculty immediately to develop a plan to complete the pre-requisites.** The nursing faculties are Donna Cluesman, Deborah Clarkston and Deborah Wright, located in Robb Hall. RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

NURSING (RN) APPLICANTS

Applicants who have lived permanently in the following jurisdictions for twelve consecutive months prior to February 1, 2010 will receive priority consideration for admission as long as they meet the minimum admission requirements:

Virginia: Lee, Wise, Scott, and Dickenson Counties, and the City of Norton

Tennessee: Sullivan County and the city of Kingsport

Residents from all other jurisdictions will not be admitted unless space remains available after these have been admitted. Although we welcome applications from residents of other jurisdictions, based on recent experience, it is unlikely that students from a jurisdiction other than the locations listed above will gain admission to the program.

If you have a question regarding your jurisdiction status, please contact Enrollment Services immediately upon applying to the program.

I request that my name be placed in consideration for admission to the Full-time Day Associate Degree Nursing (RN) Program(s) for the 2010-2011 school year. **I understand that I must submit an application/reapply for each year I wish to be considered.**
