Travel back in time as you interact with travelers and settlers from the 1790's at the Wilderness Road Blockhouse. Learn what life was like during the time of Daniel Boone and the purpose of the Wilderness Road Blockhouse. The Blockhouse will be open 2-4 pm Saturdays and Sundays May through October.

View the Natural Tunnel from the inside! Saturday, June 7, at 2 pm, Stock Creek Passage will take you on a hiking journey through the Natural Tunnel while you see how this 850 foot tunnel was formed. Meet at the Visitor Center parking lot. There will be some strenuous walking over rocks and we will be hiking in Stock Creek. NO open toe shoes, backless shoes or flip-flops/crocks please.
